Africa Energy conference to focus on oil and gas on the continent

Delegates attending the "Africa Energy Week" conference in Cape Town will today look at oil and gas in Africa. Different sessions will deal with collaboration and investment implications.

The three day gathering of governments and corporate investors in Africa will deliberate on oil related issues, gas exploration and the environment. The conference chairperson from Venezuela, Alirio Parra, says they will talk about problems and opportunities that are still there and the discoveries in the continent in the last few years.

"In environment, we look at putting all aspects of environmental air problems and energy together. We do not want to avoid looking at the possibility of an emerging strong African position with respect to the forthcoming Copenhagen meeting," Parra said.
